

Consonant Blends fl, gl, pl, sl



Parents! Consonant blends combine two (sometimes three) consonants together to make a blended sound. L blends are when the letter l teams up with another consonant to make sounds like fl, gl, pl, and sl. To learn all the l blend words in this book, watch the learning video with your child and practice sounding out the words on this page.



In every consonant blend, you can hear each sound that the letters make.

Practice making the fl, gl, pl, and sl sounds with your child. Ask your child to point to each word on this page and say the word out loud. Listen carefully to the consonant blend at the beginning of each word.




