

# Consonant Blends sp, sn, st



**Parents!** Consonant blends are two (sometimes three) consonants that come together. In a consonant blend, you can hear the individual sound each letter makes. When the consonant s is followed by another consonant, we call this an s blend. This book presents the following s blends: sp, sn, and st. Watch the learning video with your child and help your child practice the consonant blends.



Ask your child to point to each word on this page and say it out loud. Pay special attention to the sp, sn, and st sounds in each word. Note that st can come at the beginning of a word (stop) or at the end (fast).

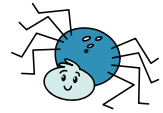

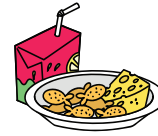

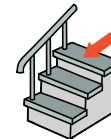
