

Digraph sh



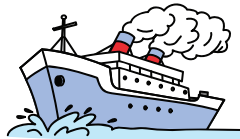
Parents! Fat Cat Level 1 contains a number of words that begin or end with the digraph sh. Digraphs are two letters that combine to make one sound like sh, ch, and th. Watch our learning video about the digraph sh and help your child become familiar with the words on this page.

When the letters s and h come together, they make a new sound, sh. The digraph sh sounds like the beginning of the word “ship.”

shell



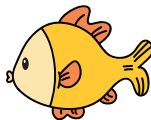
